At our manufacturing locations, during the production of these products we actively look for opportunities to continuously reduce our impacts on the environment. Our special focus lies on emissions to air, minimizing greenhouse gas emissions (e.g. by increasing energy efficiency), collective action to ensure a responsible management of water and the reduction of waste.

Norma Group is managing these aspects by setting up an environmental management system at each manufacturing location in order to prevent environmental incidents or, in case of an incident, react accordingly to minimize the effects.
